Scholarship Specifics

Humanitarian Scholarship Fund of Iowa will be awarded during the Spring semester of the 2024-25 academic year. Awards may vary based on financial need, number of recipients, and total scholarship funds available.

Scholarship Eligibility

To be eligible for an HSF Scholarship, students must meet the following criteria:

- Must be a former resident of Ukraine displaced by the current conflict
- Must have graduated from high school in the state of Iowa
- Must be accepted and planning to attend a college or trade school in Iowa
- A minimum GPA of 3.0

Deadline

Completed applications and required documents must be submitted no later than December 1, 2025. Recipients will be notified by December 15, 2025.
